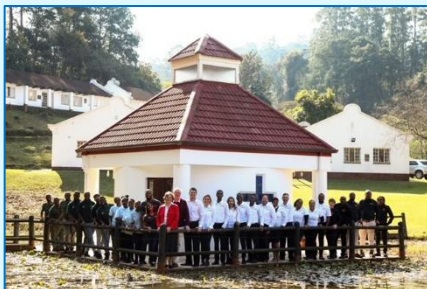

**AE ETHIOPIA** hosted a Regional High School Summit aimed at strengthening youth leadership and spiritual development towards the end of last year. During the summit, 3,515 discipleship books were distributed to equip students with biblical tools for personal growth and community impact. It served as a platform for vision casting, leadership training, and mobilising young people as agents of transformation in their schools and beyond.

### Training And Equipping Church Leaders

In September 2025, **AE RWANDA** began its initiative of training 51 lead trainers representing major evangelical denominations across Rwanda. Their workshops focused on the first chapter of the book of James - embracing Trials, asking for Wisdom and believing with Perseverance and Hope.

The impact has spread rapidly across the country. Over 1,000 pastors were equipped and strengthened by December 2025. Collectively, these pastors shepherd more than 214,000 believers, meaning that this outreach is not only touching individual leaders but influencing entire congregations, strengthening faith, restoring hope, and igniting transformation throughout Rwanda's church community. AE Rwanda is providing ongoing support.



### New Hope – New Skills



**AE GHANA** reached more than 120,000 people with the Good News of salvation in their mission outreach to Accra from 24th October to 2nd November 2025. A team of 530 missionaries and 250 churches joined the AE Ghana Team in engaging people of all ages as well as providing practical support such as health screenings and clothing banks. Over 6,200 people responded and came to Christ.



On 12 November 2025, **AE GHANA** also started its bakery and soap-making training programme to equip people with skills to generate sustainable income for themselves and their families.
